



FCC S.A. PROVIDES MORE THAN 1 MILLION BRAZILIAN REALS TO SOCIAL PROJECTS

At the end of last year Fábrica Carioca de Catalisadores (FCC S.A.) provided, by means of fiscal incentives legislation, more than 1 million reals to projects aiming at the social, cultural and economic development of neighboring communities. The resources were destined for institutions providing improved access to culture, education, health, sport and income generation for families with vulnerabilities.

The purpose of this input was to strengthen its commitment with Sustainability through programs which change and positively impact society.

FIA – Fundação para a Infância e Adolescência – (Foundation for Infancy and Adolescence) R\$ 149.472,36

Instituto Sorrir para Vida! (Institute Smile for Life!)

With headquarters in the city of São Paulo this project aims at providing dental treatment to the beneficiaries, that is, to treat an already installed problem such as dental cavities, considered one of the most common oral diseases, especially among infants.

Núcleo Social Roger Fernandes Rodrigues (Roger Fernandes Rodrigues Social Hub)

The "Bem-Me-Quer com Música II" (Bem-Me-Quer with Music II) Project is implemented in Cariacica, Espírito Santo State, provides music workshop to more than 36 (thirty-six) children and adolescents with vulnerabilities, in the practice of musical activities, strengthening family and community connections, besides acting to prevent high-risk situations and promote access to quality of life.

Lei Rouanet - (Rouanet Law) R\$ 597.889,00

Instituto Brasileiro de Música e Educação (Brazilian Institute for Music and Education)

By means of free musical workshops before/after school the Som+Eu (Sound + Me) Project organizes orchestras, develops professional capacitation and promotes a series of events, aggregating children and youngsters. Under the sponsorship of FCC S.A., the project works as a hub in Santa Cruz/RJ, at the historical Isabel Princess Palace, a building launched in 1881 by the then Pedro II Emperor; the project assists nearly 150 students.

Agência do Bem! (The Goodness Agency!)

The Music and Citizenship Schools project exists for 14 years, keeping community centers for free music education, chiefly of orchestra instruments, for low-income children and youngsters, offering weekly courses on music theory and perception, instrumental practice and citizenship. The project includes a vocational orchestra. Its focus is to democratize access to culture, launching opportunities for personal and professional training. The funds of the FCC S.A contribution support a music hub in Itaguaí, a municipality of Rio de Janeiro, assisting more than 70 children.

With headquarters in Fortaleza, the Longevidade com Dignidade: Cuidar, Proteger e Promover anos I, II e III (Longevity with Dignity: Take care, Protect and Promote years I, II and III) project supports nearly 200 elderly with dignified and humanized care. The project aims at sponsoring the maintenance of the activities of the long stay host service provided by the Home, including food, medicines and daily inputs, activities aiming at keeping the elderly active social life as well as offering playful activities.
